RECORDING AND FILMING OF MEETINGS

- ♣ Members of the public and press are permitted to record or film meetings to which they have permitted access
- ♣ Members of the public must be aware of Data Protection laws concerning the filming or recording of other people and respect their rights, particularly with regard to the filming or recording of minors

This includes refraining from editing an image or views expressed in a way that may ridicule or show lack of respect towards those being filmed or recorded.
- ♣ These requirements will be deemed to have been accepted whether the public has read them or not.
